### **Students from American and Canadian universities at the SUM**

In order to encourage young foreign scholars to study at the Institute, the Faculty Council has decided to permit the students of Italian professors teaching in US and Canadian universities to attend our educational programmes, even for just one semester. Both doctoral and post-doctoral students may apply.

Candidates may apply for one doctoral programme only, specifying their choice of semester. Successful applicants will be required to attend the lectures, seminars and other teaching activities envisaged by the doctoral programme in which they are taking part, and are also expected to reside in the city where the programme is being run. At the end of the semester, each student will receive a certificate with details of their studies and the credits they have accrued.

The Istituto will provide accommodation for students attending the courses.

Students will not have to pay any tuitions fees or other taxes, though they must have health insurance.

Applications, together with a curriculum and a motivated reason for wanting to study at the institute, must be sent by post to the following address: Istituto Italiano di Scienze Umane, Palazzo Strozzi, piazza Strozzi, 50123, Firenze.
